NFPA 1081 Industrial Exterior Fire Brigade Training

This 40-hour course provides emergency response personnel with a solid foundation of knowledge and skills that may be used to safely resolve an emergency in a plant facility in compliance with NFPA 1081.

Participant will gain confidence in their abilities to handle a variety of emergency situations through classroom and field exercises. Upon successful completion of course curriculum and certification testing, participants will receive certification from NPQS, National Board on Fire Service Professional Qualifications (Pro-Board).

NFPA 472 Hazardous Materials Incident Command Training

This 16-hour course addresses OSHA's requirements per 29 CFR 1910.120 (q)(6)(v) and competencies in NFPA 472, chapter 5 and Tentative Interim Amendment (TIA) 97-1. The participant will be exposed to the ICS/IMS to gain greater knowledge for controlling the overall incident. Table top exercise as well as field scenarios will be conducted.

Certification at HazMat Operations level is required.
